I would like to invite your child to attend a new and exciting R&P trip to Bristol to enhance their understanding of the Easter story and the history of Christianity in our local area. This will take place on **Thursday 28 March 2019**, we will leave the school straight after morning registration and return by 3pm so that pupils are able to use their normal transport methods to return home that day.

The trip will involve visiting the **New Room in Bristol** which is the oldest Methodist building in the world. Following a short and interactive introduction, pupils will have the opportunity to carry out a number of investigative activities in the new museum, recently constructed by the Bristol-based design company, Cod Steaks famous for their work on Wallace and Gromit.

They will also visit the **Bristol Cathedral** which dates back to 1140 and is one of the most interesting buildings in the city. After a tour of the Cathedral, your child will have the opportunity to take part in a creative workshop, which will develop their knowledge of the Easter Story as well as allowing them to explore and compare their own beliefs.

Please can your child bring an outdoor weatherproof coat and a packed lunch. Lunches will be provided by the school for those who receive free school meals.
